A Message from the Head of School



My heartfelt thanks to all of you whose names appear throughout this annual report. The generosity of the MPH community is as gratifying as it is vital to the operations of our School. Your contributions to the Annual Campaign allow us to stretch beyond the ordinary to offer an exceptional education, one that stimulates, challenges, and excites our children.

As I write, students in the Coville Theater are working on the lighting for the Upper School's December production of "HAIR." It will be Central New York's first high school production of the groundbreaking 1960s rock musical. Seventh Graders are collaborating online with students in Nigeria to develop local solutions to the global problem of maritime safety and pollution. After raising and releasing real Monarch butterflies, Kindergarten students have just written notes to youngsters in Mexico who will watch over their paper butterflies this winter as participants in Journey North's symbolic butterfly migration. Sixth Graders are about to board a bus that will take them to the Catskills, where they will participate in the Frost Valley environmental education and team-building program.

I can point to an enormous array of experiential programs like these that are a hallmark of MPH. While these opportunities inarguably invigorate learning and expand student horizons, tuition alone cannot support all of them. In very large measure, your gifts to the Annual Campaign allow us to do all that we do – from offering a rich menu of extracurricular activities and an innovative curriculum taught by extraordinary faculty to expanding our services and outreach initiatives for our alumni across the country. We do, indeed, get a lot of bang from your buck.

Be assured that each gift to MPH, whether to the Annual Campaign or the Capital Campaign, is a profoundly sound investment. The Board of Trustees, its Finance Committee and Investment Subcommittee are diligent in working with the administration to prudently manage every dollar received. Together, we operate a tight budget and handle the School's finances conservatively.

It is important for today's students and for future generations alike.

On behalf of the Board of Trustees, I would like to thank those of you whose names appear in this report. You have made a difference in many lives. We are indebted to you for your generosity and vision.

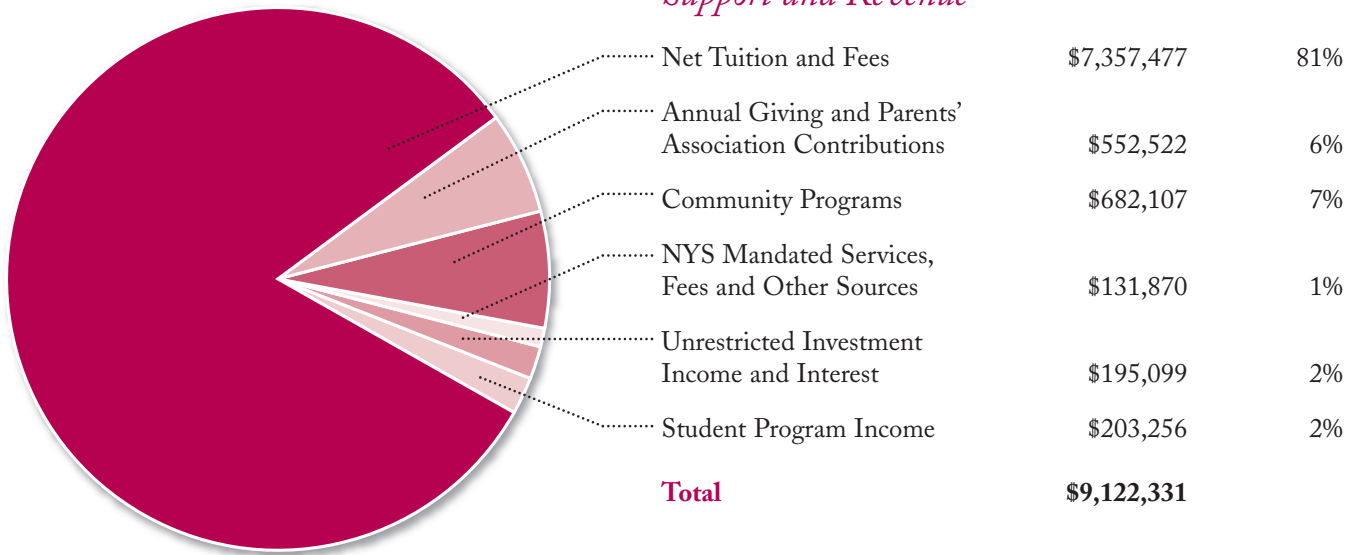

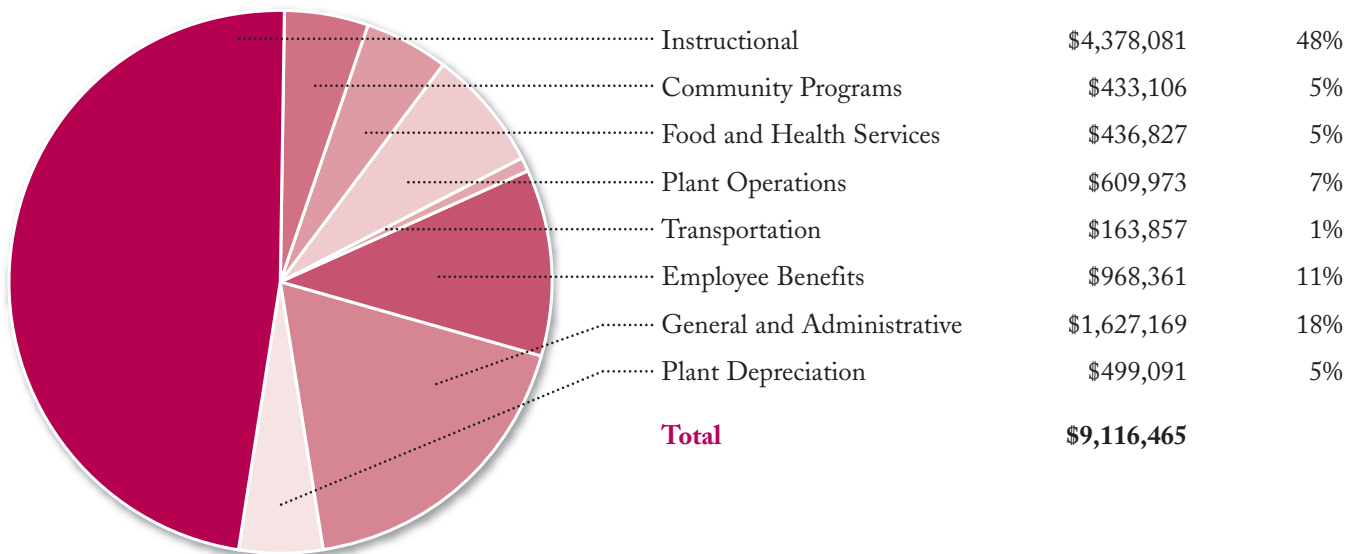

Ways to Give to Manlius Pebble Hill School

Cash

While there are many ways to give to the School, a cash gift is the most common and often the easiest. Checks can be made payable to Manlius Pebble Hill School. A credit card can also be used to make a gift or a pledge payment.

Monthly Payments

Many donors choose to make a yearly pledge with the payments deducted on a monthly basis. A variety of arrangements can be made with the development office to accommodate your needs.

Appreciated Securities or Stock

Gifts of appreciated securities or stock can be one of the most advantageous ways of giving. If your gift is a stock you have owned for more than one year, you may deduct the full fair market value of the stock as a charitable contribution, while eliminating capital gains taxes. This type of gift enables many of our friends to contribute far more to the School than would otherwise be possible.

Corporate Matching Gifts

Many employers will match your gift to Manlius Pebble Hill School. Simply submit a matching gift form, which is usually available from your human resources department, with your gift. You will be recognized for the value of your gift plus any match.

Bequest

A gift to the School made through a bequest is a symbol of commitment and a strong reminder to those who remain of unyielding philanthropy and concern for the future of education and Manlius Pebble Hill School. There are a number of simple bequest arrangements that may work for you or your loved ones.

Life Insurance

Life insurance is a unique way to give to Manlius Pebble Hill School. A gift of an existing “paid up” policy allows you to make a significant investment in educating future or current students, while receiving a tax benefit equal to the replacement value or cost basis of the policy, whichever is less. While an existing policy is preferable, the School is happy to talk about new policies or naming the School as a designated beneficiary with friends who believe this arrangement best enables them to fulfill their wish to make a major commitment to the School.

Charitable Remainder Trust

The Charitable Remainder Trust allows you to establish a trust that benefits you and/or your beneficiaries with income for life or a specified period of years and then directs the remainder value to the School when the trust terminates. Remainder Trusts are commonly of two types: the Unitrust, in which variable income is received on an annual basis, and the Annuity Trust, in which the annual payment is a fixed dollar amount. Named trusts are a wonderful way to leave your legacy to the School and receive a current income tax deduction.

Charitable Lead Trust

Charitable Lead Trusts are another way to benefit your family and Manlius Pebble Hill School. With this type of trust, the School receives an annual payment for up to 20 years and, at the end of the trust term, any money remaining can be left to your family members tax-free. If it is structured correctly and the assets grow, you can get a charitable income tax deduction, benefit the School, and have an asset remaining for family members.

Retirement Plan

Naming Manlius Pebble Hill School as the designated beneficiary of a retirement plan is another tax-efficient way of giving to the School since you could lose over 70% of your retirement plan account to income and estate taxes without proper planning.

Residential Property

In a life estate gift, you deed a remainder interest in personal residential property, a vacation home, or farm to Manlius Pebble Hill School. You and your spouse, if desired, can retain use of the property for life and receive an immediate income tax deduction for the present value of the remainder interest of the residence.

Glossary of Charitable Giving Terms

501 (c) (3): Section of the Internal Revenue Code that designates an organization as charitable, tax-exempt, and nonprofit. Organizations qualifying under the code include religious, educational, charitable, amateur athletic, scientific or literacy groups. Manlius Pebble Hill School is a 501 (c) (3) organization.

Annual Giving Campaign: The Annual Giving Campaign is a source of Manlius Pebble Hill School revenue that funds the gap between tuition and the true cost of educating a Manlius Pebble Hill student. Annual giving dollars allow the School to invest in superior faculty and programs to offer its students a top-notch education, and also helps fund our alumni program.

Annual Giving Campaign Calendar: The 12-month fiscal budget period for the School. At Manlius Pebble Hill School, the campaign runs from July 1 through June 30.

Annual Report: A report published yearly to inform the community of contributions received and an opportunity to say THANK YOU!

Appreciated Property: Property such as real estate and/or stock that has increased in value.

Beneficiary: The person or entity to whom something, usually personal property or assets, is left by will or other legal document.

Capital Campaign: An organized campaign to raise funds for the major needs of an organization, including construction, renovations, or an endowment.

Charitable Lead Trust: A trust designed to reduce beneficiaries' taxable income by first donating a portion of the trust's income to the charity and then, after a specified period of time, transferring the remainder of the trust to the beneficiaries.

Charitable Remainder Trust: A trust designed to provide an income to the donors or other individuals for life or for a term of years, with the remainder of the trust passing to the charity upon the death of the last income recipient.

Donor: An individual or organization that makes a charitable gift to an institution.

Endowment Gift: A bequest or gift that is intended to be kept permanently and invested in order to generate future income for an institution.

Fiscal Year: The 12-month financial period for the institution; Manlius Pebble Hill School's fiscal year is July 1 through June 30.

In-Kind Contributions: Gifts made to the School in the form of goods or services rather than cash, real estate, insurance or trust contributions.

Matching Gifts Program: A corporate contribution program that will match contributions made by employees, retirees and their spouses to qualifying nonprofit organizations. Each corporation establishes its own guidelines and timelines for the gift.

Nonprofit: A term describing the Internal Revenue Service's designation of an organization whose income is not used for the benefit or private gain of stockholders, directors or any other persons with an interest in the organization. (Also called Not-for-Profit)

Online Gift: A safe, secure, and fast method of making a gift via Manlius Pebble Hill School's website using a credit card. Please visit www.mph.net and click on "Giving to MPH," and then "Give Online."

Planned Giving: Financial, estate, and gift planning to build financial security, protect your heirs, and help sustain the organization in perpetuity.

Pledge: A commitment to make a gift over a specified time period.

Securities: Includes stocks, bonds and mutual fund shares.

Will: A written document that indicates an individual's wishes regarding passing on holdings to another.

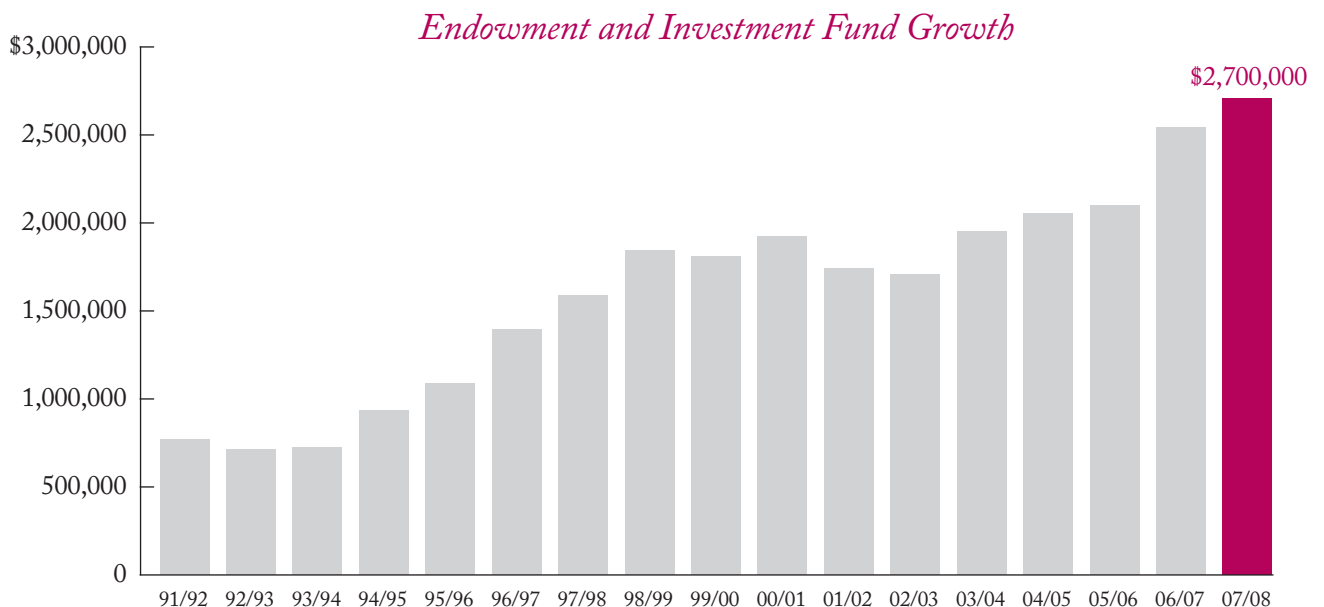
The Manlius Pebble Hill Endowment Fund

Throughout the School’s history, we have been fortunate in receiving generous support from individuals, families, and foundations whose gifts make up Manlius Pebble Hill’s growing Endowment Fund, which currently stands at just under \$2.7 million.

The School’s Board of Trustees oversees the investment of monies in the Endowment Fund, interest from which is used to support named scholarships. At present, our Endowment is small by private school standards that suggest an endowment at least three times a school’s operating budget – for MPH, an endowment of \$27 million. Recognizing that it is crucial to grow our Endowment Fund, the Board of Trustees has earmarked \$2 million of the ongoing \$6 million capital campaign specifically for the Endowment. It is the Endowment that will protect the School in the event of an unforeseen catastrophic event or emergency situation. It is what will ensure that the School continues as a vital educational institution for future generations of students.

Within the Endowment, there are numerous individual funds, which are listed below in alphabetical order. Many of these funds were initiated in the 1970s and 1980s upon the retirement or passing of former faculty, alumni, or friends. In some cases, we are unable to ascertain from old records the exact amount of the gifts made to establish a particular fund.

A brief description of each of the named funds follows, along with the total amount of accumulated capital for each. We have also recognized any new donations made in the 2007-2008 year. General Endowment Fund

A gift to the endowment is often the ultimate way to insure that future students continue to benefit from the MPH educational experience. To name a scholarship fund, our current policy dictates a minimum contribution of \$100,000 for a full scholarship or \$50,000 for a half scholarship. This endowed gift insures that funds are available for the scholarship in perpetuity.
